On behalf of the World Martial Arts Masterships Committe (WMC), I am pleased to announce that the WMC has been fully approved as an **Associate Member of GAISF** on **November 12, 2021**, during the virtual **GAISF General Assembly 2021**.

Since its founding in 2016, the WMC has proactively engaged with renowned international organizations such as UNESCO, WADA and GAISF. With such effort, the WMC officially obtained a consultative status as an NGO in official partnership with UNESCO on September 30, 2020, became a Permanent Consultative Member (PCM) of the Intergovernmental Committee for Physical Education and Sport (CIGEPS) in UNESCO on March 1, 2021, received an approval from WADA as a Code Signatory of the World Anti-Doping Code on June 11, 2021, and finally on **November 12, 2021**, the WMC became an **Associate Member of GAISF**, one of the world's most esteemed sport organizations.
